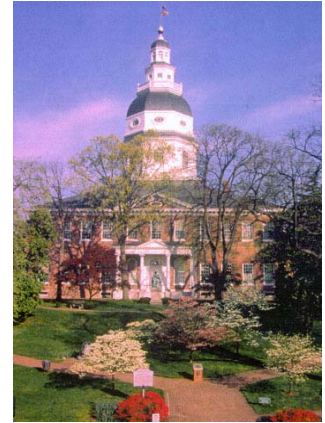




2010 MARYLAND PHARMACY LEGISLATIVE DAY Thursday, February 18, 2010

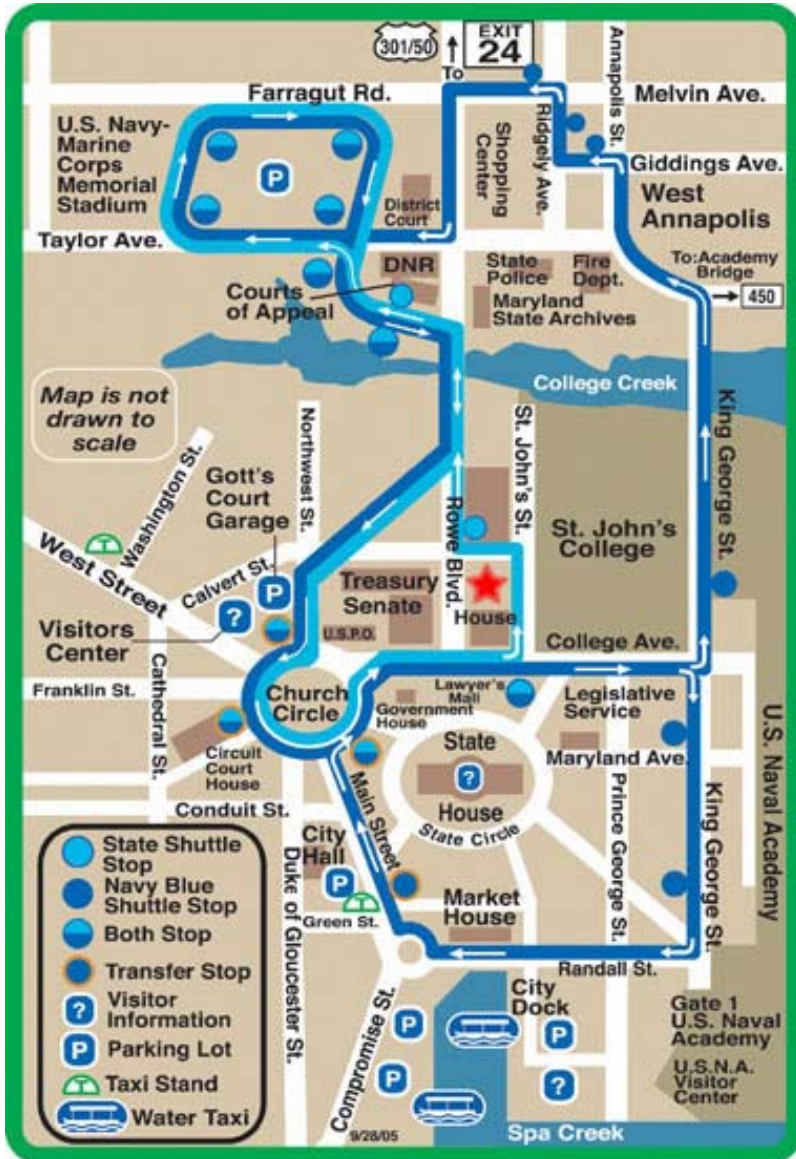

State Shuttle Hours: 6:30AM-8:00PM

- Shuttle provides free transportation from parking at Navy-Marine Corps Stadium
- Light Blue Line runs every 15 minutes and every 5 minutes during peak hours

Directions

Route 50 to Annapolis. Exit 24 to Rowe Blvd. Pass Navy-Marine Corps Stadium and pass over College Creek. The House Office building is on the left after you cross Calvert Street. To Park, follow directions below.

Parking

NAVY-MARINE CORPS STADIUM/ SHUTTLE TO DOWNTOWN: after passing the stadium on Rowe Blvd., turn right onto Taylor Ave, follow signs for public parking and make a right into the stadium parking lot, proceed to the attendant and pay \$5.00 flat rate for the day. Walk to the bus shelter and board the free State Shuttle (trolley car). Get off at the Lawyer's mall stop (beside the Legislative Service Building), walk back College Ave., and make a right onto Rowe Blvd., the House Office Building will be on the right.

GOTTS GARAGE: from Rowe Blvd., bear right onto Calvert St. to the traffic light, go straight on Calvert St. through the light. Entrance to the garage is one block on the left.

HILLMAN GARAGE: from Rowe Blvd., bear right onto Calvert St. to the traffic light, turn left onto Northwest St. and go to Church Circle. Turn right to enter circle, turn right onto Duke of Gloucester St., go straight through first traffic light. Garage entrance is on left.
